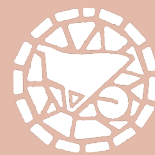

THE HOLY NAME OF JESUS

Jesus is the Word made flesh and we are called to honor
His sacred name.

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through Him, and without Him nothing came to be.”
John 1:1-3

“And the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us, and we saw His glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.”
John 1:14

POWER OF OUR VOICE

God invites us to claim the holy name of Jesus to find healing and freedom.

“And God said, ‘Let there be light and there was light.’” Genesis 1:3

EMULATE THE VOICE OF LOVE

God desires us to build with our words and our actions.

“Lord, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy mountain? Whoever walks blamelessly and does justice; who thinks the truth in his heart and slanders not with his tongue.”

Psalms 15:1-3 (from the Responsorial Psalm 9/1/24)

#2477 of Catechism of the Catholic Church explains that respect for the reputation of others forbids any attitude and word that is likely to cause another person unjust injury in these three ways:

- 1. **Rash Judgment:** We assume without a sufficient foundation the moral fault of a neighbor.*
- 2. **Detraction:** We disclose another’s failings to persons who have no right to know them.*
- 3. **Calumny:** We knowingly lie about another person intending harm upon their reputation.*

Tips to Avoid Gossip

Women often process how we feel and how to handle a situation by speaking through it. However, charity and justice also require us to honor the reputation of others. If we DO need to process externally these tips may be helpful to avoid falling into the sin of gossip:

- 1. Prayer:** We pray through the situation and ask the Lord to give us His heart, to love the people involved the way He loves them.
- 2. When/Where/Who:** If we are called to speak, we choose an appropriate time, place, and with someone who can be trusted and walks with the Lord.
- 3. No Harm:** We seek no harm, no self-exaltation, or joy and we also avoid using names to explain the situation.

“Hear me, all of you, and understand. Nothing that enters one from outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile.” Mark 7: 14-15 (from the Gospel 9/1/24)

“Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary’s greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, ‘Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy.’” Luke 1:39-44 (from the Gospel 8/18/24)
